
At time of writing in mid-2023 we have given \$21 000 of support to indigenous students. You can see past winners and apply for this award **here**.

# NGAAR WANDABAA THAWUN (Strong Spirit Ground)

The inner three circles of dots symbolise the sacred ground on which we all connect. Campsites in the shape of horseshoes indicate where we all live, work and play. The dot inside the horseshoe is a person, a leader, an elder within the campsite connecting with country and to each other, while the outer circle of dots reflects the boundary to the Spirit Ground, where we exist, to protect the earth and humanity.
